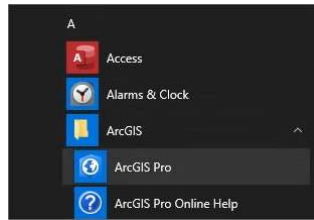
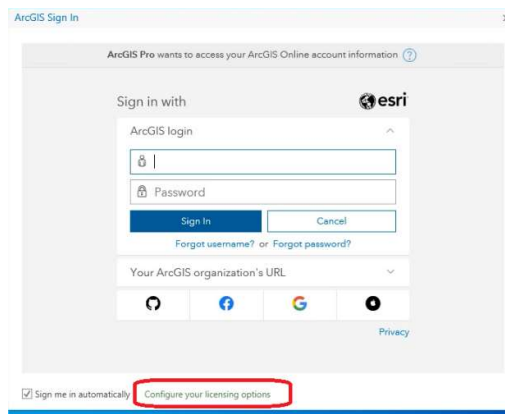


Steps in order to license ArcGIS Pro app on the DMZ1 CWS environment.

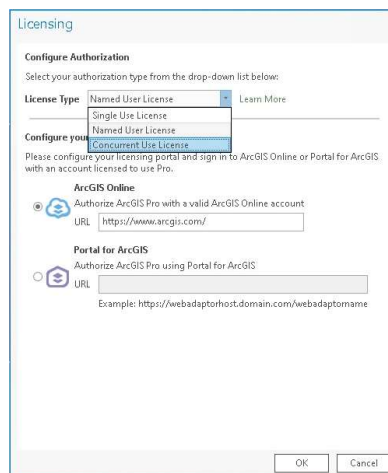
- 1) Open ArcGIS Pro software



- 2) Wait until the logon screen appears. At the Login screen, click on the green text appearing downside where it says “Configure your licensing options”.



- 3) On the “License Type” drop down select “Concurrent use license”. And wait until the new screen loads.



- In the field called "License Manager" and that is filled like "Not_Set", erase it and type: esri-lm.eea.dmz1 and click on "Refresh" (If you don't have the "Refresh" button just press Enter)
